## 2014 – 2015


It has been a significant while ordinary year for Barnabas. Does that sentence even make sense?

It has been significant in the holy places God allows our staff to walk. Every year we are privileged to walk into dark places with men and women searching for a light that lasts and to join their personal journeys toward hope. And every year, including this one, He has allowed us to have more such visits than the year before. Yet it isn't the number that matters, for each story has eternal value.

It has been significant in our pursuit of Vision 2020, the plan God gave us several years ago to expand the ministry by equipping more folks outside the office to walk in these holy places. We have equipped 32 pastors and ministry leaders to go deeper with the people to whom they minister. We have held a Pastor's Retreat, a Pastors' Wives' Retreat and a Women in Ministry Retreat for 40 folks. And we have taught and trained in over a dozen partner congregations. We are getting the privilege of multiplying our ministry by partnering synergistically with those who share our heart and calling.

But it has been ordinary in that our team continues to function as a family, supporting and encouraging, not perfectly but with loving hearts. It has been ordinary in that our Board has led us well and is purposefully leading us toward both growth and an eventual transition of leadership. It has been ordinary in that, once again, our community has supported us so that we ended in the black again (even though it was close). And it has been ordinary in the sense that God keeps showing up in the mess of life. He shows up in the dark times... often in significant ways.

As we move into 2015-16, we look forward to all that is new, and to even more of the same ordinary journey that feels like being faithful. Thanks for your part in that journey.

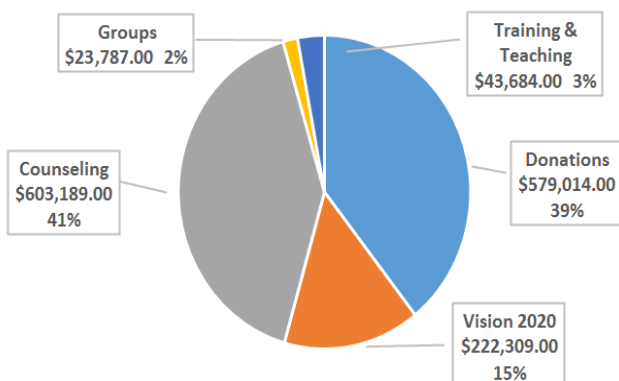
